EVANSVILLE, IN - The NAACP Evansville and Vicinity Branch Requests a Full and Transparent Investigation into the Officer Involved Shooting of Mr. Everett Nunn.

The Evansville and Vicinity Branch of the NAACP extend our deepest condolences to the family, friends and community of Everett Nunn, who was fatally shot by an officer of the Evansville Police Department on the evening of November 22, 2025, on E. Louisiana Street.

I will confirm that the Department has reached out to the Evansville NAACP to arrange a private viewing of the body-worn camera footage once it has been prepared. We intend to review this footage with the seriousness and urgency this moment demands. As we await that opportunity, we remain clear about the following:

- The public deserves transparency and accountability.
- The community deserves timely, accurate information.
- Mr. Nunn's family deserves dignity, truth, and justice.

This branch will continue to monitor the investigation closely and advocate for both the integrity of the process and the protection of Black life across this city.
